Setting Up a BioShield Canister

Equipment:

Hose

BioShield Canister

Spray Gun + Tip

Waste Container Relevant PPE

- First, remove the dust cap from the valve of the canister.
- Take the smaller end of the hose and attach it to the canister valve, be sure to tighten this with a spanner to prevent leaks.
- Take the larger end of the hose and attach it to the gun, tighten with a spanner.



Turn on the canister at the valve, check all assemblies for leaks and tighten if necessary

- Using a spanner, remove the spray tip from the gun
- Spray the canister into a waste container until a strong jet of sanitiser is achieved
- The tip should be removed to ensure that any potential debris in the hose/gun system that could cause blockages is removed
- Reattach the spray tip and tighten with a spanner
- Using the trigger restrictor wheel on the gun, set the spray width to a suitable size
